THE LAWS OF GOD

I. The Meaning of Law.

- A. A system of rules, a standard, or principles of conduct.
- B. God has always used laws and always will to:
 - Reveal His will; Regulate life; Rule (administer) in the affairs of the world.
- C. Laws existed before and after the Flood, and before the Law of Moses Gen. 2:16, 17; Gen. 9:5,6
- D. The heart of God in His laws Rom. 7:12 & God's laws are always for our good.
 - 1. They do not take away good. They take away evil and keep us from evil. Like the law in the Garden.
 - (a) Freely eat.
 - (b) Do not eat.
 - (c) God had Adam and Eve's best interest in mind.
 - 2. God's laws are always to enhance our relationship to Him and others.
 - 3. God's laws set us free but freedom does not mean against the law (anti-law) or lawless.
- E. Sin started with breaking a law Genesis 2:17
 - 1.1 John 3:4 Sin is transgression of the law (anomia lawlessness).
 - 2. Lawlessness will abound in the Last Days Matt. 24:12
 - 3. Lawlessness is called the mystery of iniquity already at work 2 Thessalonians2:7,8.

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II. Lawless cry "legalism" to cloak their lawlessness

- A. Legalism is not:
- 1. Obedience
- 2. Doing good works
- 3. Denying ungodliness and worldly lusts
- 4. Avoiding being conformed to the world
- 5. Practicing Biblical separation
- 6. Being careful in following Scripture (walking circumspectly)
- 7. Holding to the principles of holiness & modesty
- 8. Sensitivity to your brothers weakness and restraining ones liberty
