Lot's Downward Path Gradually Into Sodom

1. Looking in the wrong direction and choosing by sight.

Made his decisions by sight not prayer; only considered earthly gain

2. Separated from godly people

Didn't consider the evil effects of Sodom; reared his family where there were no godly people thinking they were immune to their evil influence; looked for a wrong kind of home

3. Pitched his tent toward Sodom

Got closer to that city & lifestyle and had a better view of it

4. Dwelt there

Finds himself living in the midst of what God would judge; was vexed (to wear down; harass; oppress/torture; pain; toss

5. Sat in the gate of the city

Was under its full authority and control

DAYS OF LOT

Result of his choices

- 1. Lost his wealth
- 2. Lost two daughters and sons in law in Sodom
- 3. Didn't protect their holy honor and later they didn't protect his
- 4. Lost his wife. (Her body left Sodom but her heart never did)
- 5. His two daughter married evil men. Giving birth to the Moabites and Ammonites who were lifelong enemies of Israel
- 6. Was left to face the fruit of his own sin and disobedience. Ended up cowering in a cave stripped of everything except his life.
