- 4. John 16:23, 24 it is addressed to the Father in Jesus' Name.
- 5. James 1:6 asking in faith; nothing doubting; no hesitancy; no wondering; no double-mindedness
- 6. James 5:15-18 can work for others under an elders authority who have faith enough to call; revelation of righteousness helps to make it effective
- 7. 1 John 5:14, 15 you start the prayer already knowing God's will from His Word; you have confidence or assurance, and know it is done.
