

THE PRAYER OF FAITH

1. **Matthew 21:22** – it involves asking and believing
2. **Mark 11:24** – things you desire; it has a starting point or time when you believe, it is when you pray
receive by faith 1st; receive the fact 2nd
3. **John 15:7** – abide in fellowship and the Word abides in you
4. **John 16:23, 24** – it is addressed to the Father in Jesus' Name.
5. **James 1:6** – asking in faith; nothing doubting; no hesitancy;
no wondering; no double-mindedness
6. **James 5:15-18** – can work for others under an elders authority who have faith enough to call; revelation of righteousness helps to make it effective
7. **1 John 5:14, 15** – you start the prayer already knowing God's will from His Word; you have confidence or assurance, and know it is done.
