1. God's original creation was a family taking dominion and bearing God's image and likeness.

2. Through lies and sin, the family lost God's image, likeness, and dominion and every imaginable family problem was introduced. (L + S = FD)

3. Through Calvary's Cross, God would redeem man and restore His original intent through a new family, the Church.

4. There MUST be a strong relationship between the family and the Church in order for God's purposes to be accomplished in both places.

Noah's Ark is a good example of the importance of the two relating to each other:

- -The Ark (a type of the Church) was necessary for the preservation of the family Gen. 7:1, 13
- The building of the Ark was a family project Gen. 6:1-10
- The Ark with the family in it was on display seven days before the Flood came Gen. 7:10
- The Ark with the family in it was a place of safety built together in such a way to rise above the storm and rain Gen. 7:16, 17

Which was most important, the Ark or the Family? Both

- 5. The Good news is that Grace and Truth have come John 1:14-16
  - Grace is help, strength, empowerment & wisdom

6. There is more grace that can be released to you James 4:6

- Humility is the key to more grace

- 7. It is the Family and the Church who have the responsibility to teach and train (Deut. 6) (Matt. 28:18-20).
- 8. It is the Church that the gates of hell shall not prevail against Matt:16:18.

- 9. Blessing is affected by both our understanding of the Church (Gal. 3:29) and Family (Gen. 18:18, 19).
- 10. It is the Family where godlike character is produced (2 Tim. 1:5) and all ministry for the Church is proven (1 Tim. 3:4, 5).

- How can parents help to keep the Family and Church in proper perspective?
- Keep your family totally identified with the purposes of God expressed and fulfilled through the Church.
- 2. Endeavor to keep the unity of the Spirit between the Family and the Church (Eph. 4:3).

misunderstandings/lack of communication

double vision/mission

defaming leadership

offences/negative attitudes
