## **FREEDOM FROM CONDEMNATION**

 Because of Adam's sin, man is a sinner by nature Rom 5:19, practice Rom. 3:23, and by decree Rom. 3:9; 5:18 (under sin & a condemning sentence or condemnation)

Adam's practice of sin changed his nature and position

- Jesus paid the price to forgive our sins, recreate us & remove the condemnation/sentence/impending doom
  - We are declared righteous 2 Cor. 5:21; & get a new nature Eph.4:24
  - We are no longer under condemnation Christ Rm. 8:1

In Christ, our nature and position is to change our practice

- 3. Three sources of condemnation/guilt we deal with and can defeat
  - 1. Sin's condemnation (conviction)/guilt 1 Jn. 3:20, 21
  - 2. Self condemnation/guilt Rm. 14:22
  - 3. Satanic condemnation/guilt 1 Tim. 3:6; Rev. 12:10

## Satan's Lie

You are a <u>sinner</u> because you sometimes sin.

You get your identity from what you have done.

You get your identity from what people say about you.

Your <u>behavior determines</u> <u>your belief</u> about yourself.

## God's Truth

You are a <u>saint</u> who may sin but can reign over it

You get your identity from what God has **done** for you.

You get your identity from what God **says** about you.

Your <u>belief</u> about yourself <u>determines</u> <u>your behavior</u>.
