III. Why Positional Truths

- A. They reveal all the past tense facts of our redemption that make our <u>relationship</u> with God possible.
- B. They establish the order of grace first, God's work in Jesus 1st, as the basis for our <u>living</u> the Christian life.
- C. How to recognize them:
 - 1. <u>Descriptions</u> of our new standing before God like "in," "with," "by," "through," Him or Christ
 - 2. <u>Doctrines</u> that reveal a work or action done in the past (Cross)

POSITIONAL TRUTH

Truths that:

- Describe a spiritual fact, truth, or reality.
- Pertain to the spiritual realm, heavenly realm, and in our spirit.
- Uncover all of what was credited (charged/imputed) to our account for being In Christ.
- Reveal how God views us as to our standing & status (rights/privileges) before Him
- Tell me what was DONE for me by grace

POSITIONAL VERSUS EXPERIENTIAL TRUTH

Standing (Spiritual Position)

- 1. The result of the work of Christ on the Cross.
- 2. It becomes ours by faith in Jesus Christ the moment we are saved.
- 3. It is perfect and complete.
- 4. Our standing is the same as every other child of God.
- 5. Our standing is entirely based on grace.

State (Natural Condition)

- 1. The result of our work, faithfulness, and practice.
- 2. It becomes ours by our day to day walk& working out our salvation .
- 3. It can improve or it can get worse; it can fall short of perfection.
- 4. Our state is <u>not</u> the same as every other child of God.
- 5. Our state is based on our faith and obedience; it is the basis of our rewards.
