

FAITH IS AN ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I. Faith is more than a movement

- A. Always has and always will be important Heb. 11:6
- B. In every time period commended due to their faith – “by faith”

II. Faith is an acknowledgement

- A. Philemon 6 - faith made effectual/active
- B. Acknowledge every good thing in you in Christ
 1. New spiritual position “In Christ.”
 2. Saying it is so Psalm 107:2
 3. What He has said we boldly say Heb. 13:5, 6
 4. Opposite is denial – saying no to a fact; saying it isn’t so; refuse to accept as true; reject as unreal, unfounded, not your own
