Psalm 118:6; Psalm 56:3, 4; Proverb 29:25

1. The fear of man is rooted in the fear of being judged and rejected. It is the underlying power of peer pressure.
2. People who know and experience that they are loved, accepted, and needed by God have a deep sense of security to resist this fear.
3. Having unrealistic expectations can set us up for rejection.
 - It would be nice if everyone liked me , but not necessary.
 - Rejection does not mean we are no good or that we are defective.
 - One person's rejection is simply their opinion, not everyone's.
 - Rejection can do you a favor and keep you from something or someone not good for you.
