

WHAT DOES “NOT UNDER THE LAW” MEAN?

Romans 6:14 **Were not under the Law's:**

1. **Covenant** Lev. 26:46; Ps. 147:19, 20; Rom 9:4
2. **Covenant of works** Rom. 4;4,5; 11:6
 - order of blessing (conditional) - obligation 1st/blessing 2nd
 - power depended upon - man's flesh/works
3. **Condemnation** Rom. 3:19, 20; James 2:10; Rom. 8:1
4. **Curse** Gal. 3:10, 11, 13; Col. 2:14
5. **Ceremonies/Sacrifices** Heb. 8:8-13; 10:1-14

IT DOES NOT MEAN WE ARE LAWLESS UNDER GRACE

1. Grace did not make sinful things less sinful. Sin is still sin and in the NT defined as transgression of the law [1 Jn. 3:4](#).
2. The morality of the law, its validity, did not change; our relationship to it changed. It is established, fulfilled, and internalized in us [Rom. 3:31; 8:4; Heb. 8:10; 10:16](#)
3. What is good and evil, right and wrong, and sin comes from God's character which existed before the Law He gave Moses and exists after. His character doesn't change.
4. Under grace we are under the law of God [1 Cor. 9:21](#) and the law of Christ [Gal. 6:2](#).
