- B. Concerns itself with restoration

II. What Makes Redemption Necessary

- A. Some form of bondage exists that necessitates redemption
- B. Bondage of sin, sickness, satan, and the curse

III. Jesus Is Our Ransom Payment

- A. Matthew 20:28; 1 Timothy 2:6
- B. 1 Peter 1:18-20; Romans 3:24 His payment releases us

IV. We Are the Redeemed & Yet Await A Future Redemption

- A. Ephesians 1:7; Romans 8:23
- B. Psalm 107:2 Gather proof; establish record of payment; & say so

THE REDEMPTION OF OUR BODY

- 1. 1 Cor. 15:35 38 It will not be the same body that was laid in the grave.
- **2.** 1 Cor. 15:39-42 It will be glorious and seems to suggest we'll differ from one another in glory.
- **3.** 1 Cor. 15:42-44 It will be incorruptible, immortal, full of strength, powerful, and spiritual body.
- 4. Lk. 20:35, 36 It will be "like the angels" or equal to angels.
- 5. 1 Cor. 15:45-49 It will be like Jesus' resurrection body.
 - a. Jn. 20:14 17 It has substance/composition (a heavenly material)
 - b. Jn. 20:16,19,20,27 It has characteristics similar in identity as a human
 - c. Jn. 20:26,27 It has the ability to operate in both the natural physical realm and the supernatural spiritual realm.
 - d. Lk. 24:36-39 It has flesh and bone but no blood.
 - e. Lk. 24:41-43 It has the capability of eating, drinking, and breathing.
 - f. Lk. 24:51; Ac. 1:9 11 It can supersede the laws of gravity
