- A. John 8:44
- B. We see his lying nature in several appearances
 - 1. In the Garden; In the temptation of Jesus; in the Early Church
 - 2. In his last appearances in the Last Days/antichrist

II. We need honesty and for the lies to stop

- A. Honesty is serious in God's eyes: 9th & 5th Commandments
- B. Honesty is the basis of trust in all relationships

III. Personal responsibility toward lies

- A. Eph. 4:15, 25; Col. 3:9
- B. Lying can become an easy habit; a trap;
- C. Always tell the truth & you never have to remember what you said

EIGHT GREAT REASONS TO TELL THE TRUTH

Telling the truth:

- 1. Lets everyone know what really happened (Less chance of misunderstandings, confusion, or conflict).
- 2. Protects innocent people from being blamed or punished.
- 3. Allows everyone to learn from what happened.
- 4. Usually get in less trouble telling the truth than lying & getting caught.
- 5. Other people trust you more when you tell the truth.
- 6. You don't have to tell more lies to keep your story straight.
- 7. You gain a reputation for being truthful. (A trait most people value).
- 8. Helps you feel secure and peaceful inside.
