## NO CONDEMNATION IN CHRIST

- 1. The Bible reveals all men were made sinners by Adam's sin, all have sinned personally, and all are under the condemnation of God Rom. 5:19; Rom. 3:23; Rom. 5:18 (sinners by nature/practice/decree)
- 2. Jesus was made to be sin for us so we could be made righteous and there is now no condemnation to those that are in Christ 2 Cor. 5:21: Rom. 8:1.
- Any condemnation that remains in us about confessed/forgiven sin:
  - Affects faith/confidence toward God 1 John 3:20, 21
  - Affects drawing close to God in worship, prayer, His Word & assembling together with people in church Heb. 10:22, 25
  - Affects our discernment & resistance to the voice of the accuser Rev. 12:10
- 3. We are not designed to live with guilt & condemnation. Know their source:
  - 1. Sin's guilt/condemnation (conviction) 1 Jn. 3:20, 21; Rom. 2:15
  - 2. Self guilt/condemnation Rm. 14:22
  - 3. Satanic guilt/condemnation 1 Tim. 3:6; Rev. 12:10
