ANCHORED

I. Spirit, soul, and body

- A. 1 Thess. 5:23
- B. Mind, will, emotions Where a person thinks, decides, feels

II. The soul needs an anchor

- A. Heb. 6:18, 19 Hope set before us is an anchor of the soul
- B. An anchor to a boat in water: prevents movement; keeps it from drifting; holds it firmly in place; keeps it stable in a storm
- C. Storms: physical; emotional; mental; family; financial; spiritual
- D. Spiritual storms: Jonah 1:4, 5; Jesus Lk. 8:22-25; Acts 27:20-25

III. There is an anchor

- A. Hope set before us in a promise is from a God Who cannot lie
- B. Hope from a promise we lay hold of is from a blood covenant
- C. It connects us (beyond the veil) into God's inner Sanctuary where Jesus our High Priest has already gone on before us.
