II. A "yet to be" experience of power to work in us

- **A. Eph. 1:19-23** Even after their initial connection to power they needed a revelation of the power of the Resurrection
 - v. 19 power that raised Christ is the power that saved us
 - v. 20, 21 power seated Christ far above all spiritual forces
 - v. 22 power put all things in subjection to Christ to be the Head over all things
 - v. 23 power to manifest the fullness of God through us
 - B. Eph. 1:19 power for us who believe for our daily life
 - C. Eph. 3:20 power to do beyond what we think or ask in prayer
 - D. Eph. 6:10 power to stand, be strong and win any warfare

POWER FOR US WHO BELIEVE

I. The surpassing greatness of His power

- **A. Eph. 1:19** God's mighty power that raised Christ is the same power that saved us (miracle working power; energizing power; ruling power; strengthening power)
- **B. Eph. 1:20, 21** God's mighty power seated Christ at God's right hand far above all spiritual forces
- **C. Eph. 1:22** God's mighty power put all things in subjection to Christ and gave Him to be the Head over all things to the Church
- **D. Eph. 1:23** God's mighty power is at work in us so that we will overcome any opposition and as the Church, His Body, manifest the fullness of God
- **E. 1 Peter 1:4, 5** It is the same power that is here to keep/protect us
