

Redeemed From The Bondage of Sickness

I. The bondage of sickness

A. Luke 13:10-17 Spirit of infirmity (sickness, disease, weakness, frailty)

1. Satan hath **bound** (physically incapacitated/ill);

2. She needs loosed from this **bond** (shackle, impediment, disability)

B. vv. 15, 16 Ought not this woman be healed being a daughter of Abraham

C. Sickness is called **affliction, captivity, curse, anguish, destruction, oppression, & bondage**/not a blessing Job 37:23; 42:10; Dt. 28:61; Ps. 41:3; 107:20; Acts 10:38

II. How valuable is the human body?

A. 1 Cor. 6:20; 1 Thess. 5:23 – So valuable that Jesus bought it & wants it preserved

B. Rom. 8:11,23; 1 Thess. 4:13-18 – So valuable He provided a redemption for it whether by resurrection or rapture

C. Is. 53:4, 5; Matt. 8:16, 17 – So valuable He paid a severe price to heal it. He said in celebrating Communion that He gave His Body for us (Luke 22:19)

D. Heb. 10:5-10 – So valuable that without a body He could have done nothing for us

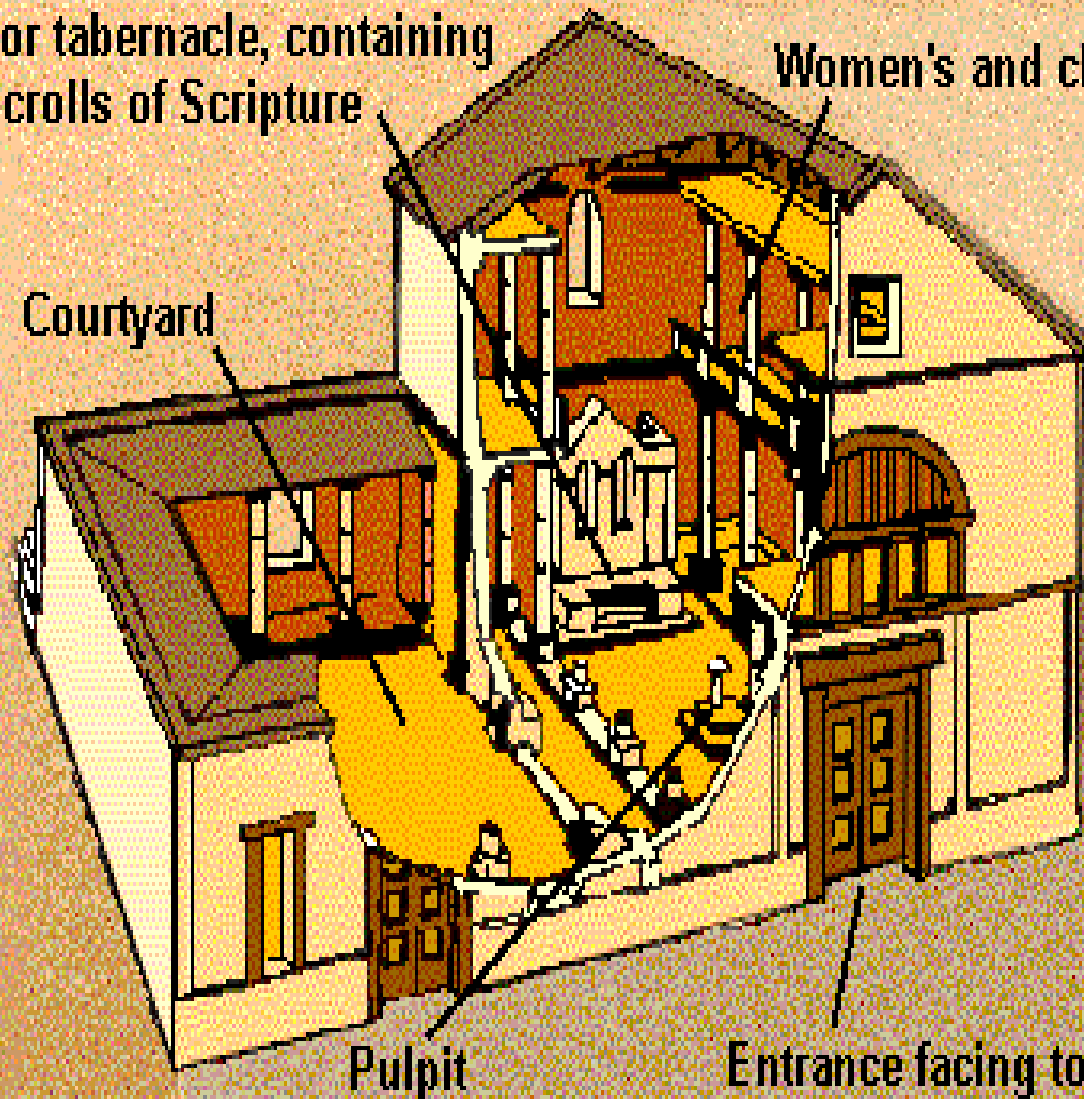
E. Submit to God's Word 2. Put resistance against sickness 3. Speak what you believe
