## I. Redeemed

- A. The word itself means release through payment of a ransom
- B. It carries the idea of bondage or some form of bondage exists that necessitates redemption.
- C. Primarily concerns itself with restoration of what once was or to its original state.

## II. The bondage which necessitates redemption

- A. Rom. 5:12 - Spiritual – Sin (sin nature or law of sin and death & our own sins)
- B. Lk. 13:11-13 - Sickness
- C. Heb. 2:14, 15 - Fear & subjection to satan's rule
- D. Gal. 3:13, 14 - The Law and its curse
- E. Rom. 8:21 - The Fall and its curse

## III. Jesus our ransom payment

- A. Matt. 20:28; 1 Tim. 2:6; 1 Pet. 1:18-20
- B. Rom. 3:24; Eph. 1:7 - By His Blood according to grace; We have redemption
- C. We are the redeemed from sin, sickness, satan, curse of the Law and curse of the Fall
- D. Rev. 5:9 – Being redeemed by His Blood is the theme of Heaven's new song
