HE RESTORETH MY SOUL

I. Jesus paid the price to restore our soul

- A. Psalm 23:3
- B. 1 Thess. 5:23 Jesus died to pay the price to restore us spirit, soul, & body
- C. God's plan is called: renewing of the mind Rm. 12:2; saving of the soul James 1:21

II. The most neglected provision of grace

- A. We have the mind of Christ 1 Cor. 2:16 but we must know where we have it
 - 1. It gives us hope that anything can be fixed in our mind because "the fix is in."
 - 2. We have it because we have the Scriptures which contain His mind
 - 3. We have it in our spirit because we have the Holy Spirit in us 1 Cor. 2:9-13
 - 4. God, by His grace, put His provisions within our spirit like in 2 Tim. 1:7
- B. We do not have it in our natural mind or automatically think like Christ's mind.
- C. If we had it in our natural mind we wouldn't have to renew our mind
- D. Real damage took place (Eph. 2:1-3); its residue/that which remains is carried over in our soul James 1:21

III. A restored soul is

- A. A soul (mind, will, emotions) subject to or under the control of our spirit
- B. A soul that is renewed to think God's thoughts and in line with His Word
- C. A soul that is at rest with perfect peace
