## A GOOD CONSCIENCE

## I. The Holy Spirit and the power of the Blood of Jesus

- A. John 16:8; Heb. 9:14
- B. Everyone has a conscience (inner moral law that judges right & wrong)
  - 1. Not always a safe guide because it was affected by the Fall
  - 2. If it was always a safe guide we wouldn't need the Holy Spirit to convict us in our getting saved
  - 3. Bible indicates it can be: defiled, evil, seared, weak; needing purged (Titus 1:15; Heb. 10:22; 1 Tim. 4:2; 1 Cor. 8:7; Heb. 9:14)
  - 4. It should accuse (convict) us & excuse (defend) us Rom. 2:15
  - 5. We may be feeling guilty but not sinning; or sinning but not feeling guilty

## **II.** The Holy Spirit continues to work in our conscience

- A. Rom. 9:1
- B. 1 Tim. 1:18, 19; 3:19; 1 Pet. 3:16; 2 Cor. 1:12 Affects our faith, holding power, withstanding false accusations, and gives us cause for rejoicing
