

MAKE A JOYFUL NOISE

Ps. 98:4-6; Ps. 32:11; Ps. 89:15; Ps. 5:11 - Hebr. “shabach” loud adoration; to shout, to glory, to triumph; to commend, laud, or praise

Psalm 100:1 joyful noise - Hebr. “ruwa” to raise a shout or sound for joy, triumph, or in applause; to shout as in a war cry or alarm of battle or signal for war; fig. to split the ears with sound

A joyful noise is not noise for its own sake but as an expression of praise. Our praise is always to be the outward expression of our inner faith toward God.

There is spiritual significance behind spiritual sound & noise.

1. Signals and starts things in the spirit realm

Acts 2:1-4; 1 Thess. 4:16-18; 1 Kings 18:41; Joshua 6:20, 21; Zech. 4:6, 7

2. Creates warfare on the enemy

2 Kings 7:6; 2 Chron. 20:19-22

3. Brings forth/carries God’s glory (presence/power)

2 Sam. 6:9, 12, 15; 1 Chron. 15:16, 28

4. Is an energy source connected with light in the spirit realm

Ps. 89:15

5. Brings life to our soul

Ps. 66:1, 8, 9
