1. Jesus said knowing the truth is the key to our freedom and it comes by continuing in His Word John 8:31, 32; John 17:17

- Strongholds (2 Cor. 10:3-5) start with a thought that is a lie.

2. The enemy to freedom, the devil, uses lies to blind, deceive, and keep us from perceiving the truth John 8:44.

- satan's only power is to deceive us & deception is simply believing a lie instead of the truth 2 Tim. 4:1-4; 2 Thess. 2:10; Dn. 8:12.
- What we believe influences everything we think, say, & do.
- He has to use lies because he has no legitimate authority, right, or rule.

3. Truth is first and foremost to renew our mind & as a weapon in our warfare against the devil/demons 2 Cor. 10:4, 5; Ephesians 6:10-18.

The devil's tactic is to lie to us & attack who we are or our identity.

He wants us to believe what defines who we are and what our future will be is based on:
