

A SPIRITUAL OPERATION AT SALVATION

I. The Bible portrays man as a trinity

A. Gen. 1:26, 27; 1 Thess. 5:23 – Spirit/Soul/Body

B. How the Fall affected man Eph. 2:1-3; Rom. 5:12

1. Died spiritually, his spirit separated from God Gen. 2:17; Gen. 5:5

2. Soul & body merged/joined to fallen flesh (said to be in the flesh) Rm. 7:5; 8:8

3. Physical body began to die Gen. 3:19; it became mortal (death doomed)

II. Importance of understanding our three-part being

A. Give us knowledge of what Jesus did for victory in our walk

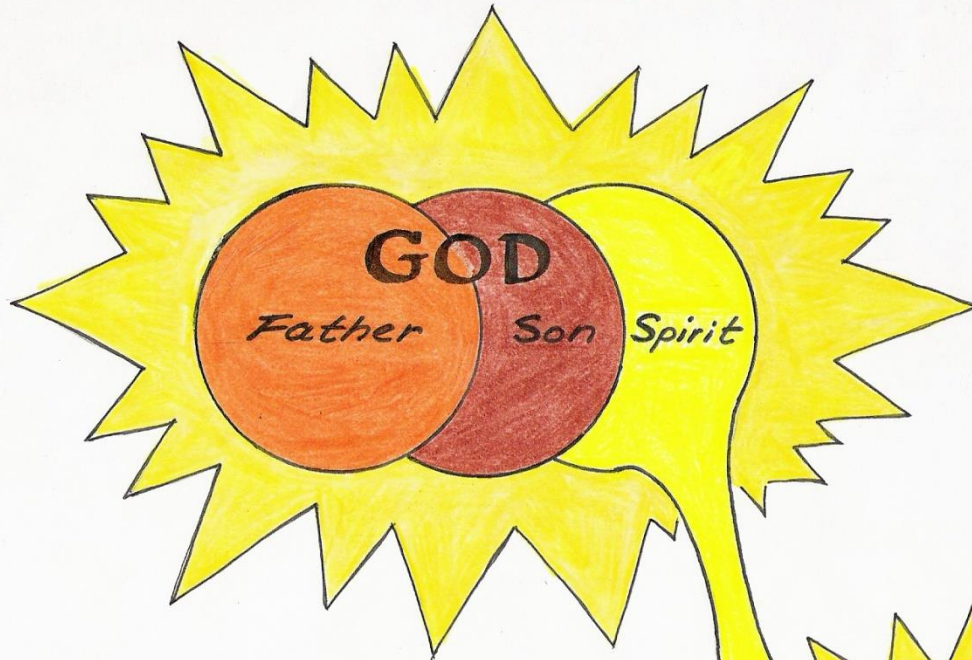
B. Expose where the power of sin dwells in us Rom. 7:18, 21, 23, 25

III. In salvation, a spiritual circumcision took place

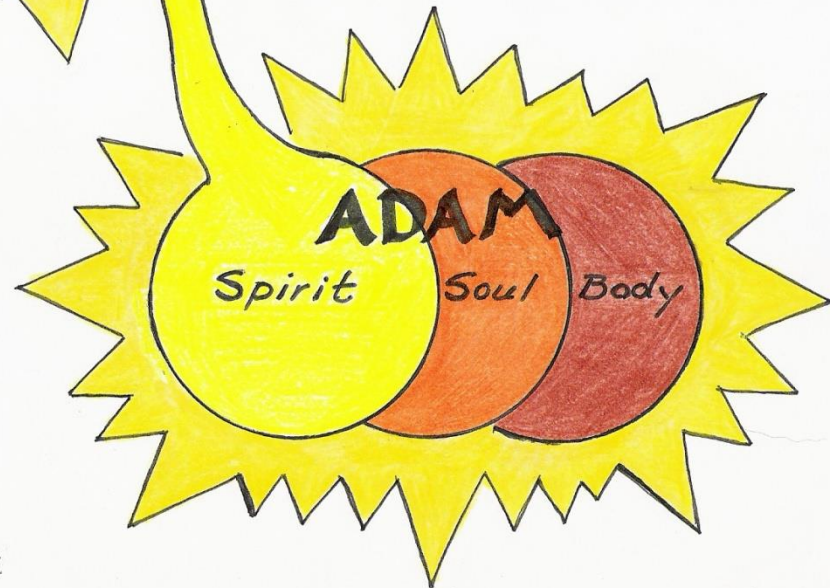
A. Col. 2:11-14 – A “cutting away,” & “cutting around”

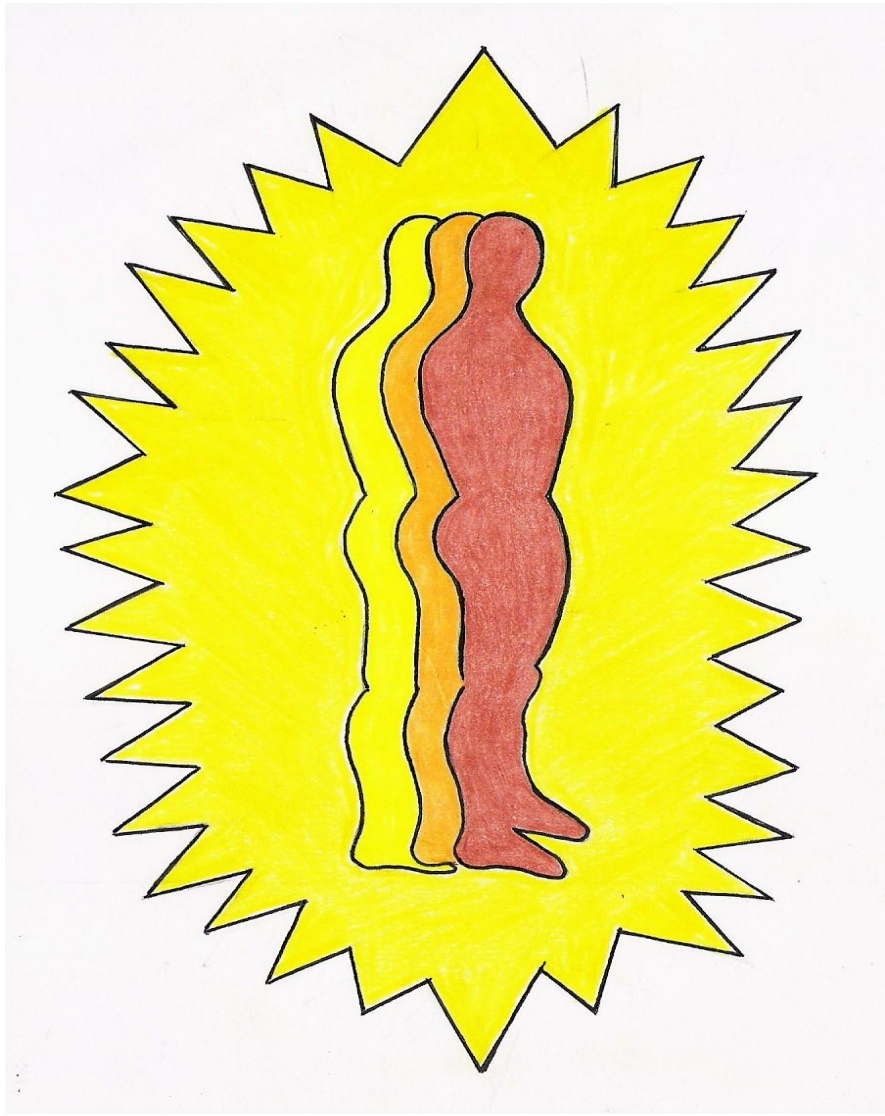
B. Rom. 2:29 – Inwardly, of the heart, in the spirit

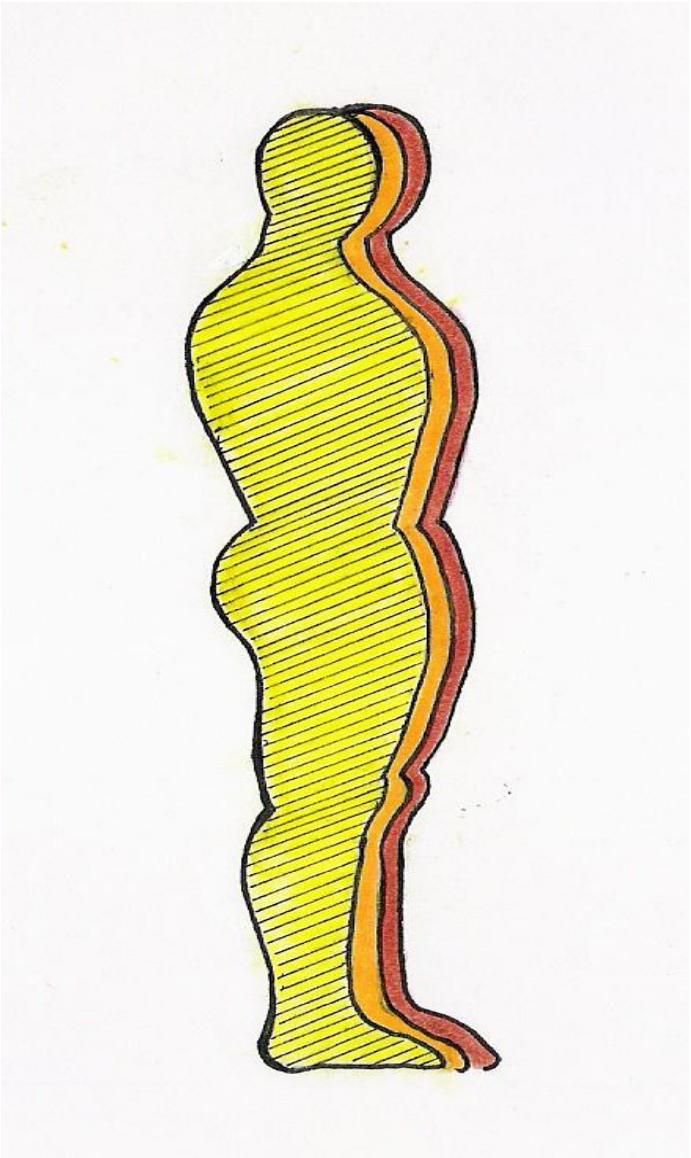
C. There has been a clean cut of our spirit from our flesh Gal. 5:16

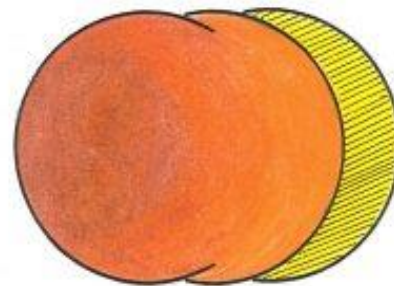
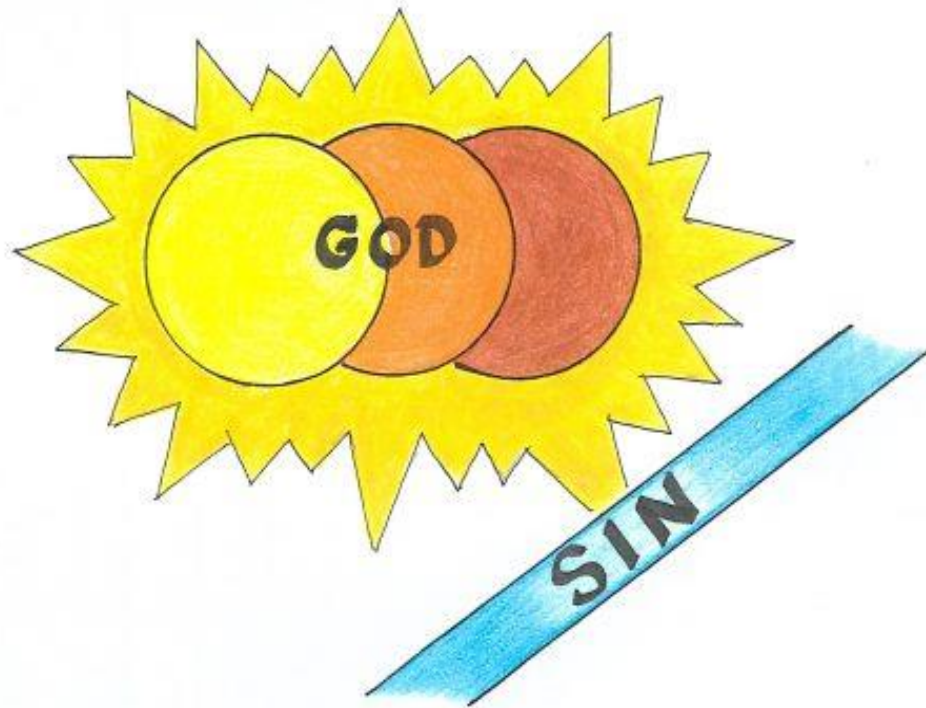
