

# KILLING IT

## I. The meaning of mortification

A. Rom. 8:13; Col. 3:5 – To put to death; trans. “killed” in Rom. 8:36  
- Crucify; subdue; bring into subjection;

B. The mortification of sin in our life as a Believer is a MUST. We cannot be passive in our walk in dealing with sin, but actively & daily be “killin it”

C. Rom. 8:1, 2, 11 Jesus redeemed us from sin’s penalty, power, presence

## II. The motive of mortification

A. Gal. 5:24; Rom. 8:3; Rom 6:14 – Positionally, in Christ, the flesh is already crucified as a fact.

B. We by faith need to reckon/account it as so Rom. 6:11

## III. The method of mortification

A. Rom. 8:13 Through the Spirit, His power, not natural power

B. Rom. 13:14; 1 Pet. 2:11 Kill it in your thoughts; Titus 2:11 deny it;

Gal. 6:8 don’t feed it; Pr. 18:21 put your words against it to resist it
