I. What is Temptation

- A. Temptation- an enticement, allurement, solicitation, or persuasion to evil.
- B. Sometimes used to describe the trying of your faith, not to sin or do evil

II. Know when temptation comes

- A. The temptation itself is not a sin Heb. 2:18; 4:15; Matt. 4:1-11
- B. Learn ahead of time from others mistakes and example 1 Cor. 10:1-11.
- C. They can be resisted, if we rid ourselves of any false sense of security 1 Cor. 10:12
- D. Temptation is common to man 1 Cor. 10:13.
- E. God is faithful in every temptation:
 - 1. To put a limit on satan
 - 2. To provide a way of escape for us
- F. We can escape many temptations by avoiding idolatry 1 Cor. 10:14
 - Covetousness and stubbornness
