I. Adam's Fall and loss of dominion

A. Gen. 1:26, 28

B. Eph. 2:1-3

C. Heb. 2:14 – 18

II. Think of dominion as including restoring control

A. 2 Cor. 5:17; 1 Thess. 5:23; Rom. 6:12 - 14

B. There are things we can control and things we cannot control

1. **Under my control** – My thoughts; words; actions; self-talk; my emotions; media I consume; things I look at, listen to; places I go; people I company with; I have a **RESPONSIBILITY** over
2. **Out of my control** – The past; other's opinions; what others think me; other people's feelings toward me; other people's attitudes & treatment of me: I can only control my **RESPONSE**
