

# THE COMFORTER WITHIN

1. God's plan has always been Jesus (Matt. 28:18-20) and the Church (fellowship Acts 2:42) to remedy loneliness and isolation.
2. God is the God of all comfort (2 Cor. 1:3-7) Who comforts us with the Scriptures (Rom. 15:4) and Holy Spirit (John 14:16).
3. Jesus knew the disciples would face a new aloneness and antagonism as He was about to leave them (John 15:17-25).  
Comforter – Greek, “Parakletos” John 14:16; 14:26; 15:26; 16:7
  - a. One called to one's side to help (or to pick up)
  - b. One Who speaks tenderly
  - c. One Who gives solace (a soothing like a medicine that relieves irritation or pain).

# EXTERNAL STRUCTURES OF THE BRAIN

## Frontal Lobe

- Motor control (premotor cortex)
- Problem solving (prefrontal area)
- Speech production (Broca's area)

## Parietal Lobe

- Touch perception (somatosensory cortex)
- Body orientation and sensory discrimination

## Temporal Lobe

- Auditory processing (hearing)
- Language comprehension (Wernicke's area)
- Memory / information retrieval

## Occipital Lobe

- Sight (visual cortex)
- Visual reception and visual interpretation

## Brainstem

- Involuntary responses

## Cerebellum

- Balance and coordination
