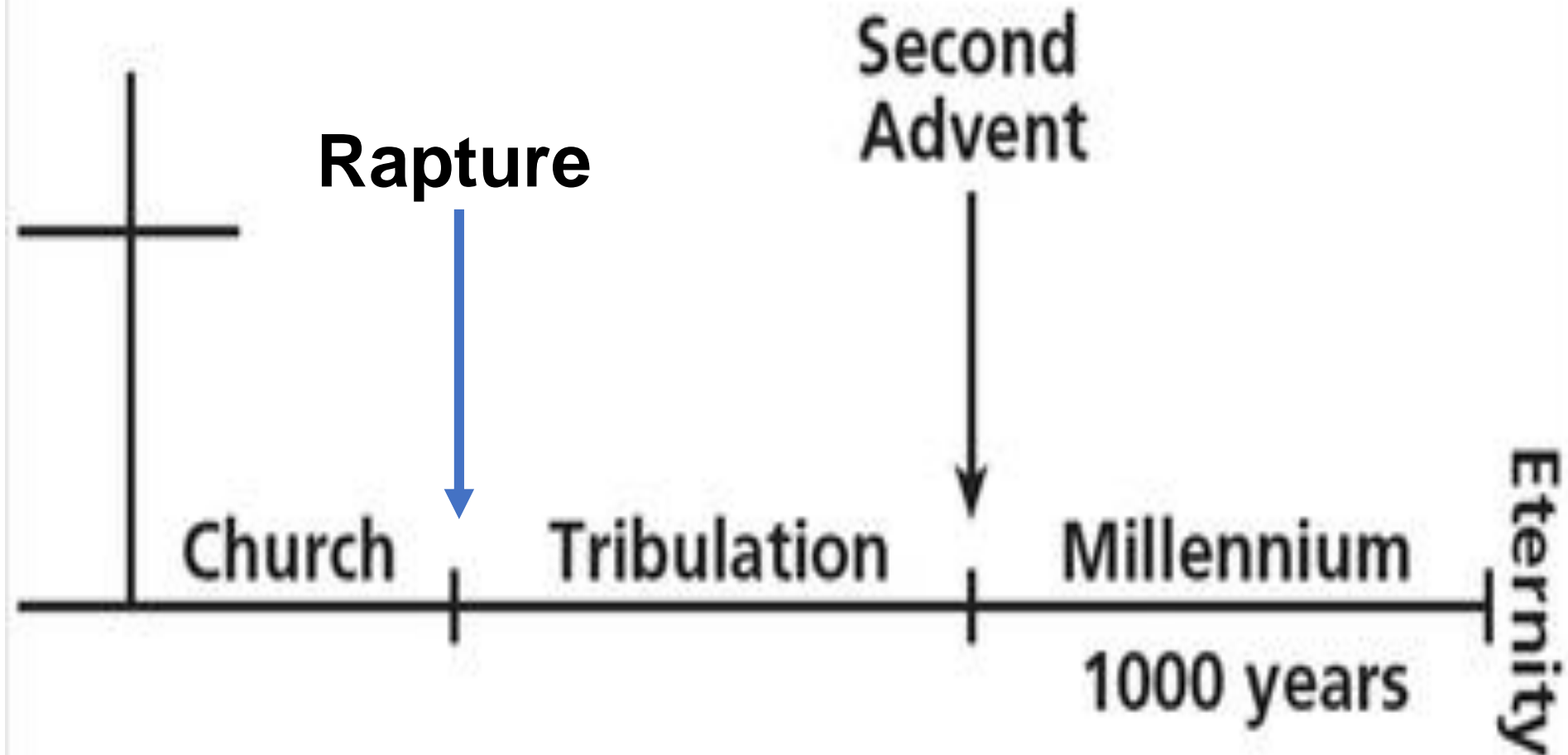

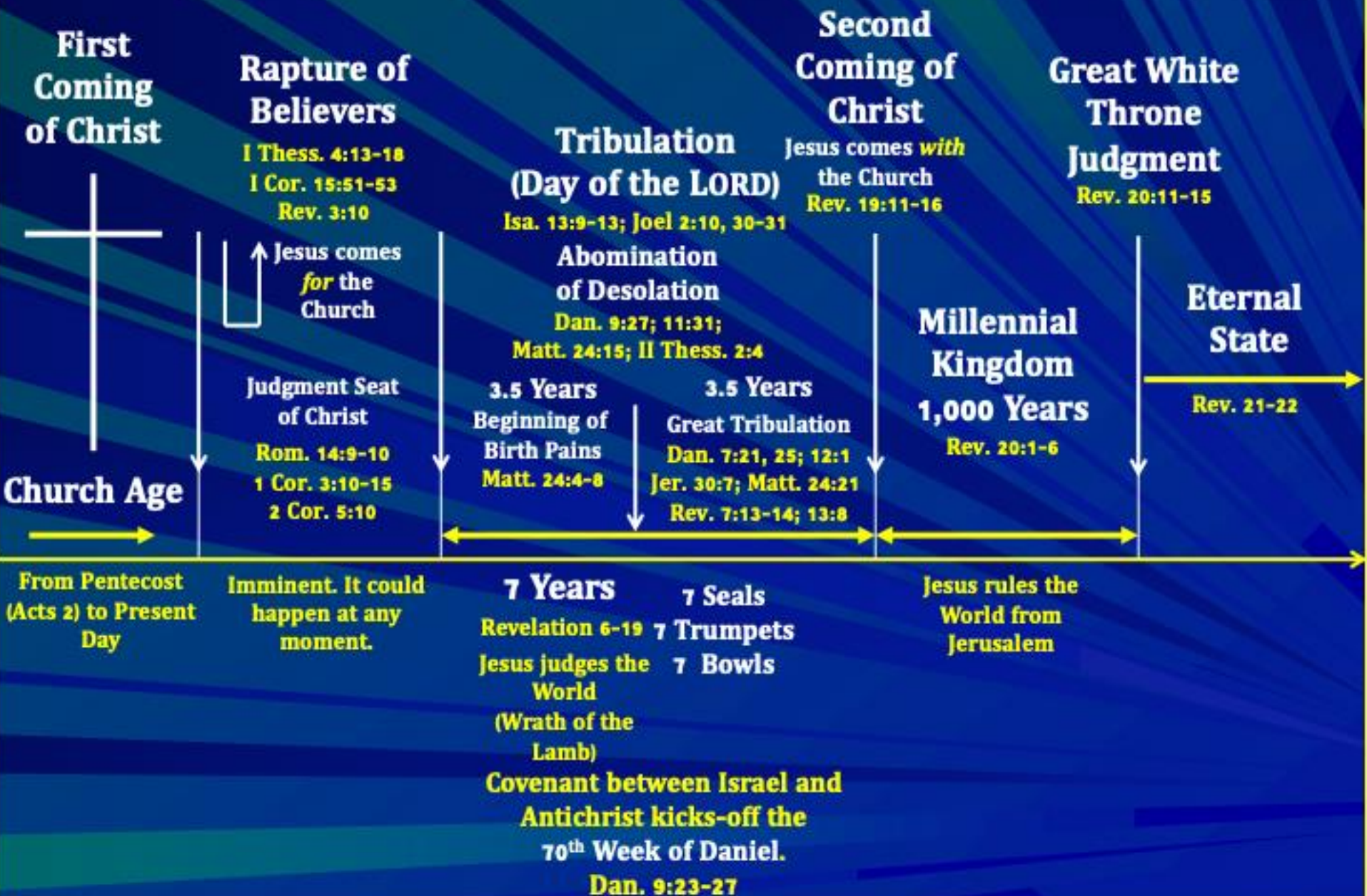

# Why Study Revelation?

- ❑ Because it promises  *blessings*  to the one who  *hears and keeps*  the words of the prophecy (cf. Rev. 1:3; 22:7).
- ❑ Because it presents the Lord Jesus Christ in all  **His glory** . It is  **His Revelation**  (cf. Rev. 1:1, 12-17).
- ❑ Because it declares that in the end, God will deal completely and forevermore with the  *problem of sin*  (cf. Rev. 20:11-15).
- ❑ Because it declares the  *eternal future glory*  of the redeemed people of God (cf. Rev. 21:1-4).
- ❑ Because  *the time for the end is near* , imminent (cf. Rev. 22:10).
